- Once you have some results write Mr Davis a set of instructions to help him grow plants.

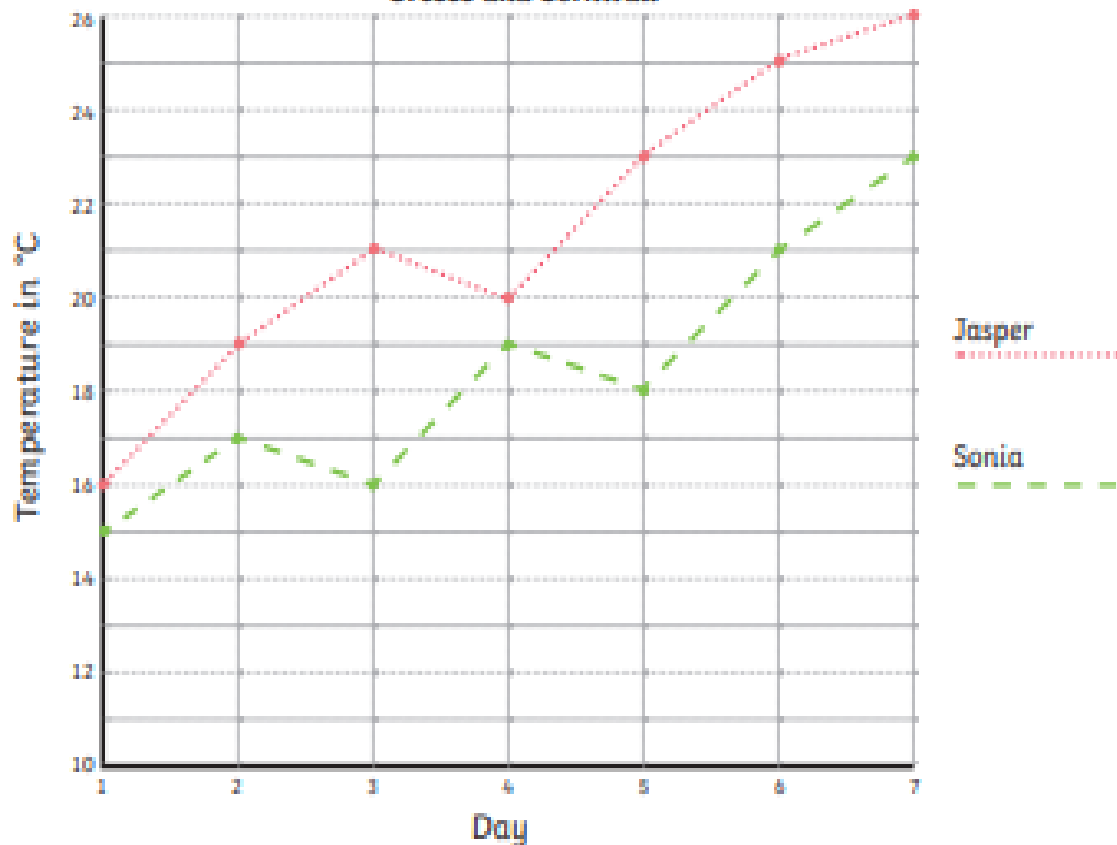


## MATHS
