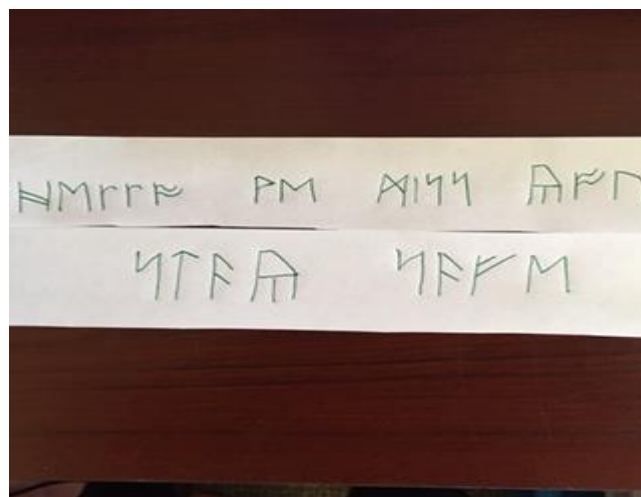
Anglo-Saxon Runes

Can you read this message?

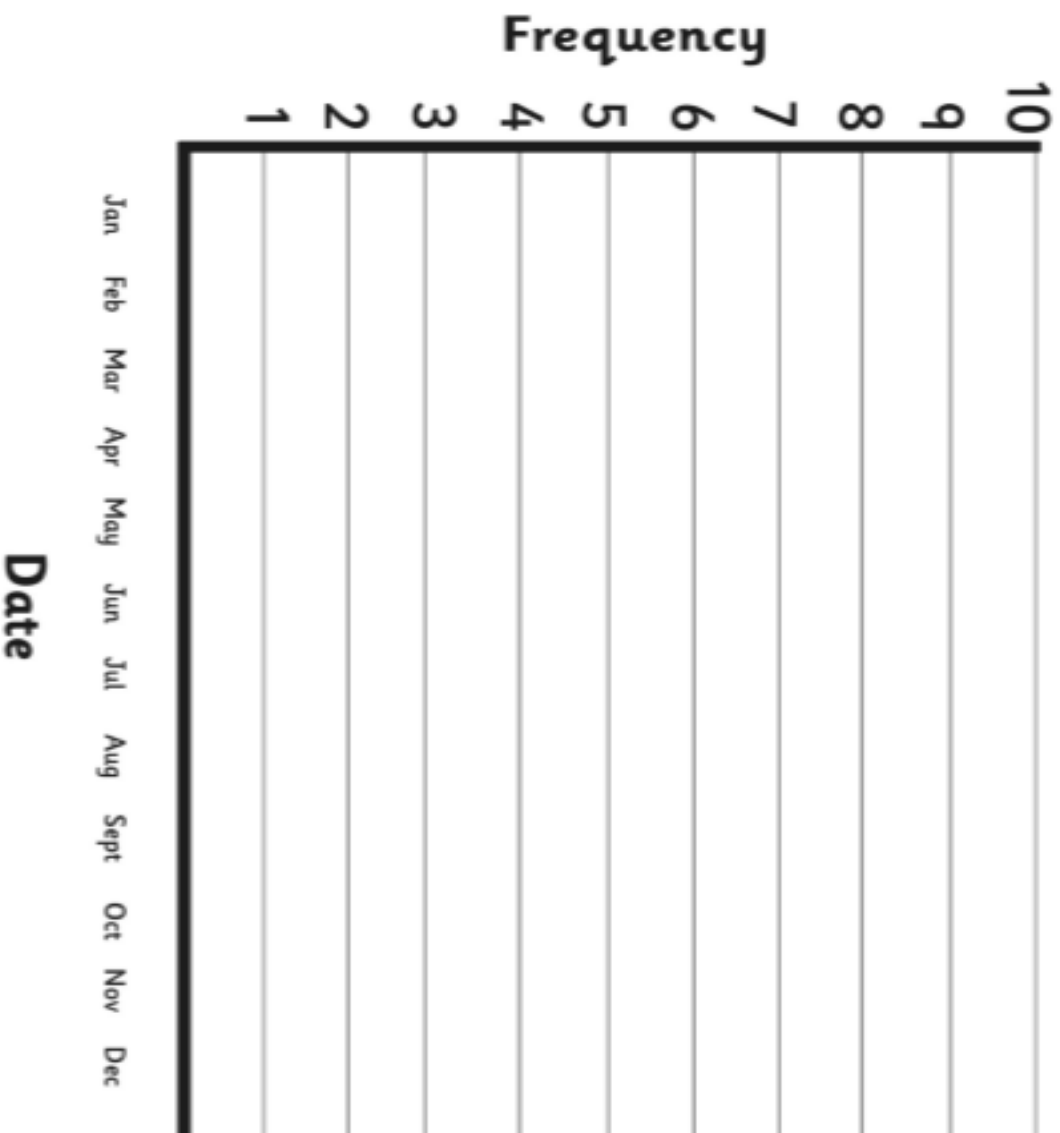


If you e-mail your secret message, we will try to decipher it (work it out).
