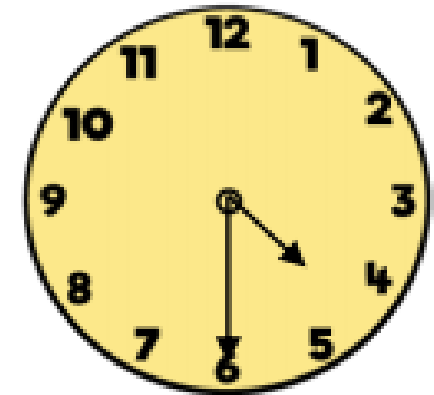
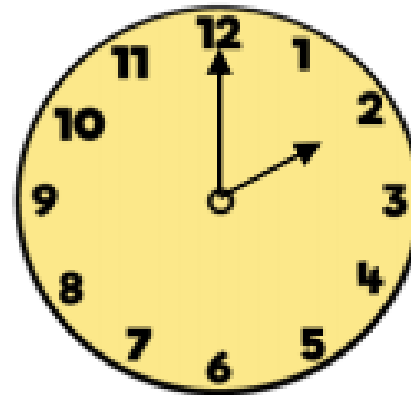

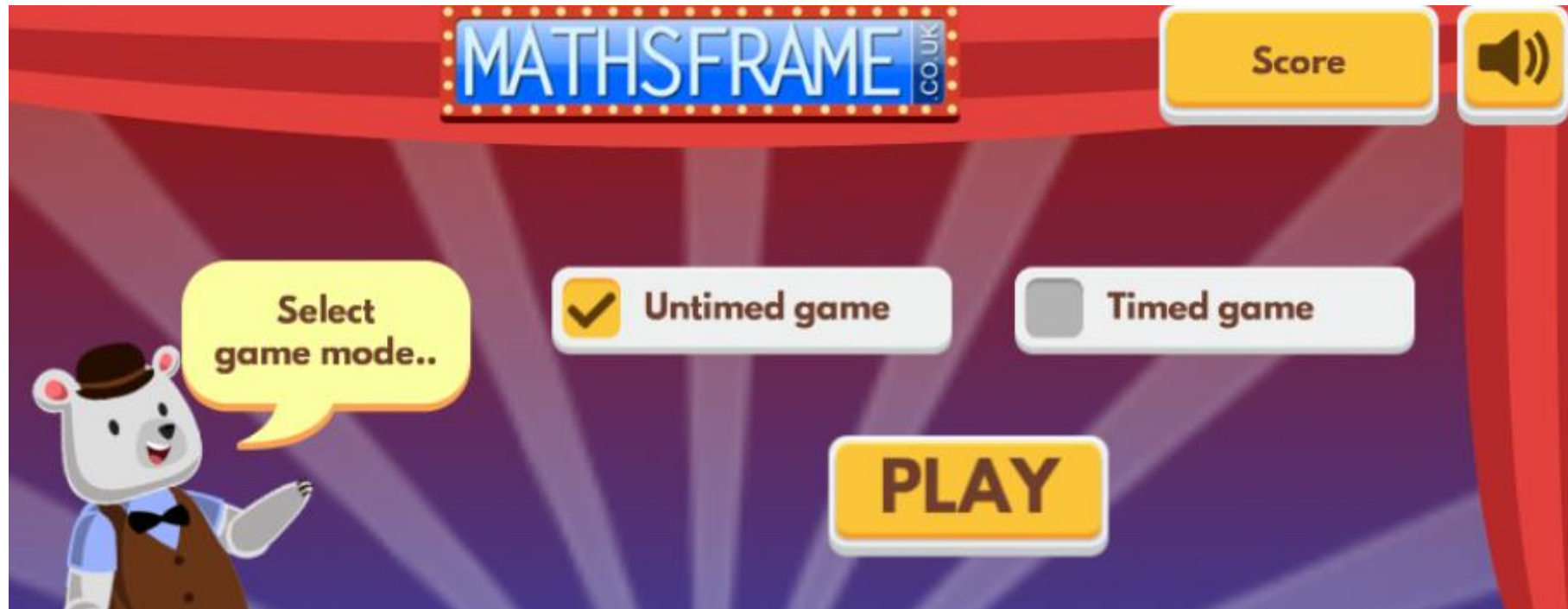
The train to Blackpool leaves at quarter past and quarter to every hour.
