

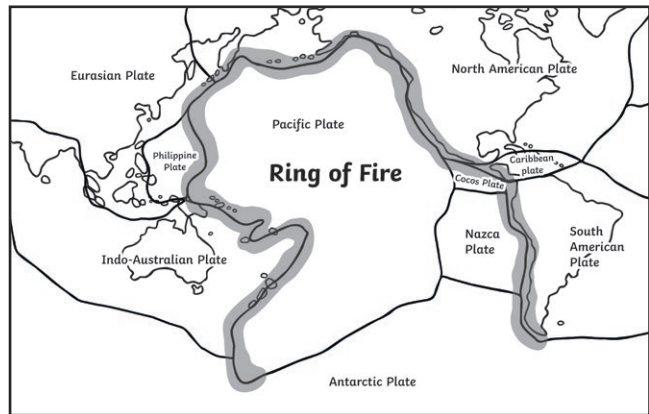
The Ring of Fire Mini Booklet
