## Sports Premium Funding

2018/2019 PE and Sports Premium Grant Terms and Conditions were released during half term. To confirm Schools will receive; £16,000 and a basic amount £10 per pupil in Years 1-6

### Payments

Maintained schools (via LA)  
7/12 of your funding 30/10/2018  
5/12 of your funding 30/4/2019

Academies, free schools and CTCs  
7/12 of your funding 1/11/2018  
5/12 of your funding 1/5/2019

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of physical education (PE), **physical activity** and sport you offer.

### Ofsted inspections

Ofsted assesses how primary schools use the primary PE and sport premium. They measure its impact on

pupil outcomes, and how effectively governors hold school leaders to account for this. You can find details of what inspectors look for in the 'effectiveness of leadership and management' section of the [Ofsted schools inspection handbook 2018](#).

### Online reporting

You must publish details of how you spend your PE and sport premium funding by the end of the summer term or by **31 July 2019 at the latest**. This is different to last year's reporting deadline. Online reporting must include:

- ✓ Amount of premium received
- ✓ Swimming attainment data for Year 6 pupils (from their most recent swimming lessons.) school.
- ✓ full breakdown of how funding has been spent
- ✓ Impact the school has seen on pupils' PE, physical activity, and sport participation and attainment

- ✓ How improvements will be sustainable in the future

You are also required to publish the % of pupils within your Year 6 cohort in the 2018 to 2019 academic year who met the national curriculum requirement to:

- ✓ Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- ✓ Use a range of strokes effectively
- ✓ perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

**Government will sample a number of schools in each local authority to review what they have published on their use of the funding and their swimming attainment. Schools are expected to spend the grant for the purpose it was provided only; to make additional and sustainable improvements to the PE, sport and physical activity offered.**

2018/2019 Sports Premium Templates will be available next week—these will be emailed with a list of appointment dates for Natalie to come and visit to assist with writing these plans if this something that would be helpful

## IMPORTANT...Raising attainment in primary school swimming

The premium can be **used to fund the professional development and training** that are available to schools to train staff to support high quality swimming and water safety lessons for their pupils.

The premium may also be **used to provide additional top-up swimming lessons to pupils who have not been able to meet the national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety after the delivery of core swimming and water safety lessons.**

Funding should not be used to:

- ✓ Employ coaches or specialist teachers to cover planning preparation and assessment (PPA)
- ✓ Teach the minimum requirements of the national curriculum – with the exception of top-up swimming lessons after pupils' completion of core lessons (or, in the case of academies and free schools, to teach your existing PE curriculum)
- ✓ Fund capital expenditure
