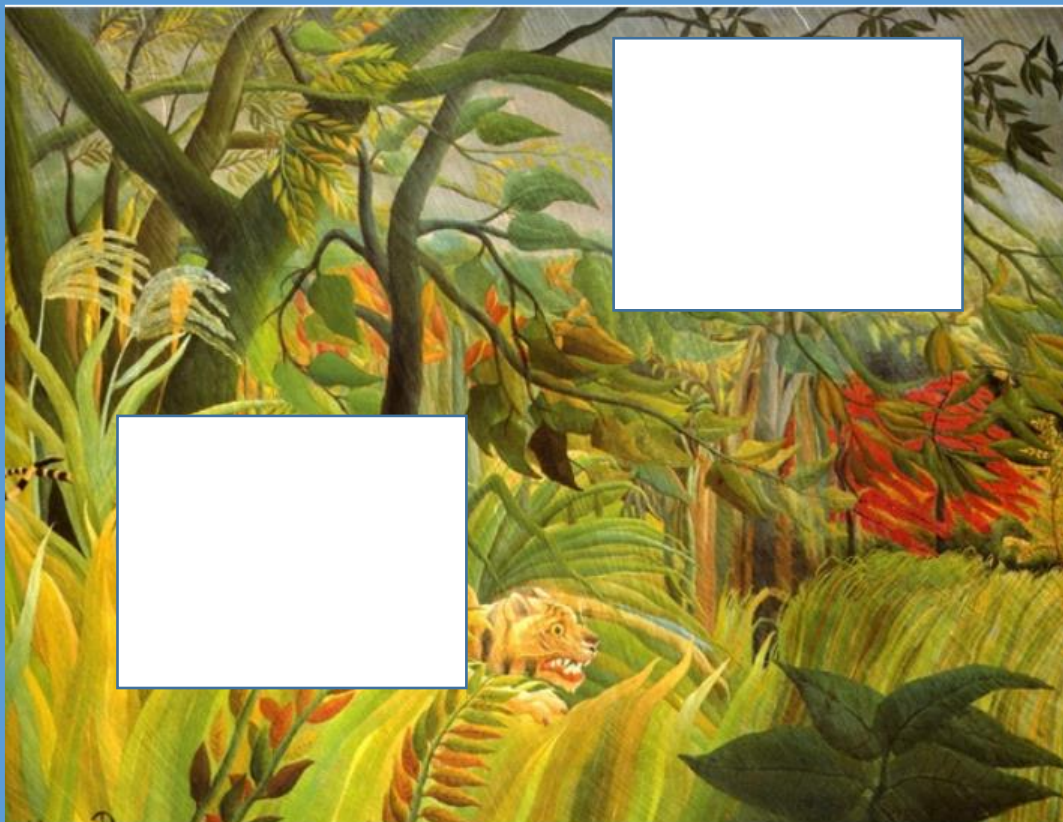
Task 3. Maths L.F - to tell the time to the nearest minute.
